Space is full of garbage. It is not the type of waste material, such as food or paper. Most of the garbage in space is metal or different pieces from the things humans <u>have</u> <u>sent</u> into space, like rockets or satellites. Some are very big pieces of metal, and others are very small pieces of paint.

The problem is that the garbage <u>is traveling</u> at a very fast speed in all directions. Because different countries are sending astronauts into space, these pieces of garbage can be very dangerous if the astronauts <u>get hit</u> by them.

There is no way for us to go and get all the garbage in space. In the future, the pieces of garbage will probably hit each other and make even more garbage. All we can do is track it carefully, but at the same time, we need to try to <u>stop adding</u> new garbage.

第5部

Have you ever heard about the Marshmallow Challenge? It is a very simple and fun game. In this game, a team of three to five people is asked to build a tower in 18 minutes. They are given 20 pieces of spaghetti, 1 yard of tape, 1 yard of string and a marshmallow. They don't have to use all of them, but the marshmallow must be at the top of the tower. Also, the tower has to stand up by itself without any support. The team with the tallest tower wins the challenge.

We can learn that the best teams have three different kinds of people in them: experts, organizers, and experimenters. First, the experts know how to build a strong structure. They tape the spaghetti into small triangle shapes because triangles are stable. Second, the organizers know how to plan a project. They help the team finish the project successfully on time. Third, the experimenters try to build a lot of different towers. They build different models until they find the right one.

Why is this challenge so popular in many schools or companies? That is because through this activity, everyone can learn how important it is to collaborate and work as a team. Why don't you try the Marshmallow Challenge?
