Was Columbus the first European to go to the Americas*1? No, he was not. The Vikings landed in the Americas long before Columbus. You have probably seen pictures of the Vikings before. They wore helmets and carried spears and shields*2. They also traveled in long boats with square sails.

The Vikings came from Scandinavia*3. Most of them were the sons of farmers. Why were people who were farmers famous for boats? It is because Vikings thought that the oldest boy in the family should take over the family farm. The younger boys, then, had nothing to do. So they got in their boats and sailed to other countries looking for more land to farm.

The Vikings were great at building ships. Their ships were strong, and they were fast. They used these boats for war, for trade, and for discovering new lands. But not all of the places that Vikings went were "new." Sometimes they tried to take land in places people already lived. Then, they had to fight with the people already settled*4 there. However, the Vikings were also good fighters.

As the Vikings explored new lands, they visited Iceland and Greenland and then went to the Americas. The first Viking to land in the Americas was Leif Erikson. He was the second of three sons of Erik the Red, the first colonizer of Greenland. There are several different records about Leif's landing in the Americas. In one story, while sailing from Norway to Greenland in around 1000, Leif was blown off course and arrived in a country he called Vinland, because of the grapes growing there and the fertility*5 of the land. In another, he heard of a land in the west from a trader and went to find it. If you go to Canada today, you can see some of the old things from a Viking town built at that time. It seems that the Vikings did not stay there long. Probably they stayed less than ten years. They may have left because the weather was getting colder. No matter what the reason was, they were long gone by the time Columbus was even born.
