No. 1 What is it?

No. 2 What is it?

It is a city located in northern Osaka prefecture, Japan. It was founded on April 1, 1940. It was the site of Expo '70, a World Fair held in 1970. The J-League soccer team, Gamba Osaka's home stadium is in the city. Hankyu Railway, West Japan Railway Company, and the Osaka Monorail run through the city. Kinran Senri Junior High School belongs to the city.

No. 3 What are they?

They are international sporting events held every four years. Thousands of athletes from all over the world take part in them. They were supposed to be held in Japan in 2020, but the schedule was changed to one year later due to the Corona virus. Winners of each game are given gold, silver and bronze medals according to the results.

No. 4 What is it?

It was built with the finest technique available at that time. It is known as "White Heron Castle" because its beautiful white walls look like a soaring white heron. In 1993, it became one of the first Japanese buildings to be chosen as a UNESCO World Heritage site. It was completed in 1609, taking eight years. The main tower survived the two big World Wars and the Great Hanshin-Awaji Earthquake in 1995. It was a

miracle indeed.

No. 5 What is it?

It is a cat robot from the 22nd century, sent to take care of a Japanese boy so that the boy's descendants can get a better life. The boy is very lazy and loves sleeping very much. The robot was created as a cat-type one, but one day while it was sleeping, a mouse bit its ears off. Its body is blue and wears a red collar with a yellow bell on it. It has a special pocket on its belly and takes out some special items when the boy needs help. Both children and adults love it very much.
