History is full of mysteries. Scientists are always trying to discover more about history. One of the most mysterious things is the Great Sphinx of Giza in Egypt. Maybe you already know about it, but there is a lot you probably don't know.

Most people know about the Great Pyramids because we see them in movies or books. But the Sphinx has many secrets too. The Sphinx looks like a giant lion's body with a human face. You can find it near the Great Pyramids.

So, what is so mysterious about the Sphinx? Many scientists think it was built about 4,500 years ago for the king of Egypt at that time. But no one really knows the true reason why it was built. Some people think it was to protect the pyramids and the king after he died.

The Sphinx was carved from one big rock. It took around three years to finish it. This was very fast compared to the Great Pyramid, which took about 20 years to build. One reason it was faster is that the workers didn't need to move huge stones like they did for the pyramids. Still, the Sphinx is an amazing piece of work.

But here's where the mystery grows. Some scientists believe the Sphinx is much older than 4,500 years. They think it could be about 9,000 years old! Why? They studied the rock and found marks that looked like damage from rain. The last time it rained heavily in Egypt was about 9,000 years ago. So maybe the Sphinx was built around that time.

Other scientists disagree. They say the marks are from strong desert winds, not rain. So which idea is correct? We don't know yet. But scientists are still studying the Sphinx, and maybe one day, we'll finally learn the truth about this giant mystery of history.

There is a film called *The Imitation Game*, released in 2014. It is based on a true story in England during World War II from 1939 to 1945. The movie is about a man who worked hard for his country, but no one remembered him until recently.

In 1939, a man named Alan Turing was 27 years old. He was a very smart mathematician. He was good at math, numbers, and puzzles. The U.K. government gave him an important job. His job was to understand Germany's secret messages.

At that time, Germany and the U.K. were fighting in the war. Both countries used secret messages to win. Germany used a special machine called *Enigma* to hide their messages. Alan could not speak German, but he thought of Enigma like a puzzle. He believed he could solve it.

Today, Alan Turing is remembered as a hero. His face is even printed on British money to respect his great work.
